INQUIRY INTO YOUNG PEOPLE WITH ACQUIRED DISABILITIES

Terms of Reference

In accordance with the Resolution of Parliament which established the Joint Standing Committee on Community Development, the Committee has resolved to inquire into the circumstances of young people with acquired disabilities.

The Committee will inquire into and report upon the needs of young people with neurological disorders and acquired disabilities, who live in institutions.

Issues relevant to this inquiry are:

1. Adequacy and suitability of existing accommodation arrangements and;
2. Alternative accommodation options and;
3. Access to other services including:
 - Transport
 - Rehabilitation
 - Social opportunities
 - Carer training, and;
4. Any matter incidental thereto.
