

**IRRIGATION COMPANY (CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS)
BILL 2011**

SECOND READING SPEECH

Mr Speaker, I move that the Bill be now read a second time.

The *Irrigation Company (Consequential Amendments) Bill 2011* makes a number of amendments to relevant Tasmanian legislation which are required as a result of the enactment of the *Irrigation Company Bill 2011*.

A number of pieces of legislation in Tasmania make reference to the Rivers and Water Supply Commission, which will cease to exist on the day on which the *Rivers and Water Supply Commission Act 1999* is repealed.

Predominately, the amendments involve substituting the name of the Rivers and Water Supply Commission in various Acts with the name of the new single State-owned company, to be known as Tasmanian Irrigation Pty Ltd.

Mr Speaker, I move the second reading of this Bill and commend the Bill to the House.
