A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Constitution Act 1934*

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Amendment (House of Assembly Electoral Boundaries) Act 2009*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.
