LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL INQUIRY INTO THE WILD FALLOW DEER POPULATION IN TASMANIA

The Legislative Council Government Administration Committee 'A' has recently determined to inquire into the wild fallow deer population in Tasmania with particular reference to:

- Environmental impacts on public and private land;
- Any impact on commercial activities on private land;
- The partly protected status of fallow deer under the Wildlife (General) Regulations 2010;
- Commercial opportunities for the use of wild population stocks; and
- Any matters incidental thereto.
