



## Parliamentary Standing Committee of Public Accounts

### Inquiry into the Administration of the Crown Lands (Shack Sites) Act 1998

The Standing Committee of Public Accounts has resolved of its own motion to examine administrative costs in relation to the Crown Lands (Shack Sites) Act 1998 and in particular report upon:

#### Terms of Reference

- (a) The legislative requirements;
- (b) The administration costs for each area in each financial year of the program;
- (c) The infrastructure costs for roads, sewerage, power and water for each area in each financial year;
- (d) The methodology used to determine administrative costs for the:-
  - a. sale of properties; and
  - b. rental arrangements;
- (e) Any variations to the methodology used and the reasons; and
- (f) Any other relevant issues.

The Committee will conduct public hearings in relation to this reference during May 2007.
