

Four Mile Creek Bridge to be Rebuilt

Labor Member for Lyons, Heather Butler, said today's announcement, by Premier Paul Lennon, of a new bridge at Four Mile Creek would bring great joy to the community.

The Premier made the announcement at a community forum in St Mary's today.

"The fires took many things from this community, but the loss of the footbridge at Four Mile Creek symbolised the divisions they brought," Mrs Butler said.

"The Break O'Day Mayor asked the State Government for support to rebuild a footbridge for the Four Mile Creek community.

"The Premier has today announced that the government will support the building of a new bridge.

"The government will work with the council over the coming months on the design, cost and funding arrangements for the bridge.

"This is another in a range of measures put in place since the fires last year.

"With support from the State Government, the Australian Government and organisations such as The Australian Red Cross, the East Coast is being rebuilt.

"Tasmania has a rich web of regional communities that are resilient and that together make us a strong state."
