New Equipment for Meander Valley Gymnastics Club

The Meander Valley Gymnastics Club is purchasing new equipment following a State Government Grant to assist local recreation organisations.

The club will be buying new landing mats and a kinder floor gym with funds from the 2007-08 Minor Grants Program administered by Sport and Recreation Tasmania.

The grant of \$633 is being matched by fundraising efforts of the club.

“The Minor Grants Program assists a range of grass roots sport and recreation organisations,” Ms Butler said.

“Organisations like the Meander Valley Gymnastics Club rely on the passion and hard work of community volunteers so the Government is delighted to be able to support the vital role they play.”

“The Government is keen to continue supporting projects that encourage all Tasmanians to be physically active.”

The gymnastic club, which was formed over 10 years ago, currently has 70 members ranging in ages from five to 13.

Sport and Recreation Tasmania has awarded more than \$142,000 in funding to 61 projects throughout the State in the first round of funding under the 2007-08 Minor Grants Program.
