St Helens Service Tasmania Shop on the Move

Parliamentary Secretary to the Premier, Heather Butler and the Mayor of the Break O'Day Council, Robert Legge, today announced that the Service Tasmania shop at St Helens will soon be moving to new premises.

Ms Butler said the new premises will be adjacent to the St Helens History and Visitor Information Centre which is located in Cecilia Street.

"The new location will provide the residents of the Break O'Day municipality with more convenient access to roughly 550 different State, Commonwealth and Local Government services," Ms Butler said.

"Customers can pay their government bills at any Service Tasmania shop, as well as purchase government products, lodge applications, make bookings and much more."

Construction for the new Service Tasmania shop will be commencing shortly with the new shop anticipated to be open before the end of August 2009.

Ms Butler said Service Tasmania has been providing the residents of St Helens and surrounding areas with customer friendly access to government information and services, for more than 10 years since opening in August 1998.

"Service Tasmania is a one stop shop to make it easier for Tasmanians, especially in rural and regional areas, to do their everyday business with government," Ms Butler said.
