## **\$1.4 MILLION REDEVELOPMENT FOR ROSE BAY HIGH**

A \$1.4 million redevelopment at Rose Bay High School will help students reach their full potential.

Speaking at the official opening of the redevelopment today, Member for Wellington Doug Parkinson said the improvements would provide the school with state-of-the-art facilities.

“The stage one redevelopment includes modifications to the Materials, Design and Technology area and new Food Technology facilities, including a new state-of-the-art kitchen,” Mr Parkinson said.

“It also includes new Music recording facilities and rehearsal rooms and new classrooms.

“The redevelopment of Rose Bay High School will give students the best possible environment to develop their talents for decades to come.

“The Education Department has recognised the link between good teaching and learning and supportive physical learning environments, and I wish current and future students well in the new facilities,” Mr Parkinson said.

The project is jointly funded by the State Government and the Australian Government.
