Backflip On Liberal-Green Conspiracy Theories

The Liberal-Green opposition are twisting their conspiracies over the appointment of a new magistrate to suit the situation they now find themselves in, Leader of the Government in the Legislative Council Doug Parkinson said today.

“Only a couple of weeks ago, the Liberal-Green opposition claimed the Premier had intervened to stop the appointment of Simon Cooper,” Mr Parkinson said.
