TUESDAY, 17 SEPTEMBER 2019

1 COUNCIL MEETS.— The Council met at 11.00 o'clock in the forenoon and the President read Prayers.

2 PETITION.— Mr *Willie* brought up an E-Petition containing 22 names and a Paper Petition containing 362 signatures (a total of 384 citizens of Tasmania) who draw attention of the House to the increasing concern in the community about the crisis in Tasmania's child safety system.

Ordered, That the Petition be received. (Mr *Willie*)

3 SPECIAL INTEREST MATTERS.— The President advised the Chamber of six Members who had indicated their desire to speak and of the order in which they were to speak as follows —

- (1) Ms *Forrest* – Epiroc;
- (2) Mr *Finch* - Tasmanian Community Fund;
- (3) Ms *Ratray* - Deloraine House;
- (4) Mrs *Hiscutt* - Sheffield School Farm;
- (5) Ms *Howlett* - Rural Alive and Well Big Blue Farmer; and
- (6) Mr *Dean* - Smoke Free zones at school crossings.

At the conclusion of Special Interest Matters the Council proceeded to Orders of the Day.

4 HOUSING LAND SUPPLY (HUNTINGFIELD) ORDER 2019.— A Motion was made (Ms *Webb*) and the Question was proposed, That the Legislative Council, in accordance with section 9(4) of the *Housing Land Supply Act 2018*, disallow the proposed *Housing Land Supply (Huntingfield) Order 2019* which was laid on the Table of the Council on 6 September 2019.

A Debate arose thereupon.

5 SITTING SUSPENDED.— It being 1.00 o'clock p.m. the Sitting of the Council was suspended.

The Council resumed the Sitting at 2.30 o'clock p.m.

6 QUESTION TIME.— The President called for Questions without Notice. There were two Questions asked.

7 HOUSING LAND SUPPLY (HUNTINGFIELD) ORDER 2019.— The Council resumed the Debate on the Question, That the Legislative Council, in accordance with section 9(4) of the *Housing Land Supply Act 2018*, disallow the proposed *Housing Land Supply (Huntingfield) Order 2019* which was laid on the Table of the Council on 6 September 2019.

Ordered, That Ms *Ratray* have leave to Table a diagram titled 'Master Planning and Housing Land Supply Order' and have the diagram incorporated into the Hansard record.

And the Question being put, That the Motion be agreed to.
