**EXAMINATION OF RECENT DEVELOPMENTS RELATING TO
MAJOR ENERGY USERS**

The Joint Select Committee on Energy Matters has resolved to undertake further targeted evidence gathering in relation to recent developments relating to energy supply and demand matters associated with current and potential future large energy users in Tasmania.

In accordance with the Inquiry's [Terms of Reference](#), the Committee will further examine recent developments relating to Tasmania's major industrials, large energy contracts and emerging large-scale energy demand/load.

The Committee's focus for its further examination are Terms of Reference paragraphs 1(b) and 1(c), which relate to the challenges and opportunities related to energy supply and energy costs in Tasmania. However, further evidence gathered may relate to the Committee's other Terms of Reference.

The Committee will invite relevant persons or organisations related to this area to make written submissions to the Committee and/or to appear as a witness at a future public hearing.
