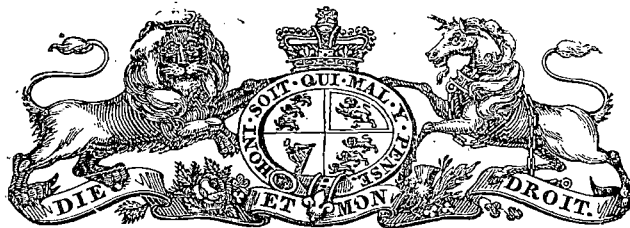

Six horses were kept back from the Bushmen Contingent as unsuitable. Two were sold, and brought £4 15s. and £3 15s. respectively. One (a gift horse) was string-halt, and was returned to his owner. One went with the Imperial Contingent, and the remaining two were returned from the Imperial Contingent, where they had been sent for another trial, and one was eventually sold; the other (a gift horse) was returned to his owner.
