



PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL:

REPORT FOR 1891.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



REPORT of the Board of Management of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL for the Year 1891.

THE total number of patients treated during the year was 67, as against 80 last year.

The amount received from paying patients was £38 12s. as against £35 18s. for 1890, showing a growing appreciation by the public of the Institution.

I regret to say that the annual subscriptions continue to fall off, having been only (in round numbers) £84 as against £92 for 1890, and £113 for 1889. I have endeavoured to impress upon the public the fact that every £1 subscribed is supplemented by a £1 from the Treasury, but there is little alteration in the names of the subscribers; and it is much to be regretted that so many should hold aloof from aiding what has now proved itself a most valuable Institution.

The 31st December finds us with a balance to debit of £19 3s.

Donations of vegetables, fruit, clothing, flowers, &c. are gratefully acknowledged from Mesdames Pitt, Riordan, Hart, Leake, Stormont; the Misses Valentine, Bell, Finlay, and Power; Messrs. C. F. Pitt, Dr. Tofft, Col. Lethbridge, Mr. Morris, and Rev. T. M'Dowell.

The Medical Officer has evinced the same deep interest in the Hospital as his predecessor, and the thanks of the subscribers are due to him for his unremitting attention.

The Clergy of the District have, as heretofore, been assiduous in their attendance upon the patients.

The Master and Matron have continued to give great satisfaction, and the Board has much pleasure in recommending them for the annual bonus.
