

By-law No. 3.

This By-law shall commence and take effect on and from the sixteenth day of April, 1889.

IN addition to the Wharfage Rates payable under By-law No. 1, Part VI., Section 1, the Wharfage Rates set forth in the Schedule hereunder written shall be paid on Horses, Sheep, and Cattle entered to be landed at the Port; and the said Schedule shall be deemed to be part of the Schedule appended to the said Section of By-law No. 1.
