

Inquiry into the Dying with Dignity Bill 2009

On 18 June 2009 the House of Assembly resolved to refer to the Joint Standing Committee on Community Development the following reference for investigation:

Terms of Reference:

The Dying with Dignity Bill 2009 together with any incidental matters.

The Dying with Dignity Bill 2009 was introduced in the House of Assembly on 26 May 2009 as a Private Members Bill and deals with the matter of voluntary euthanasia. The Bill provides for terminally ill patients who are experiencing intolerable pain and suffering to request the assistance of a doctor to end their lives.

The Committee invites written submissions from individuals and organisations with an interest in this matter. Please include all relevant detail in the written submission as verbal evidence may not be taken from all submissions. The Committee will report its findings to Parliament by 2 October 2009.
