



Joint Standing Committee on Integrity

On Wednesday, 12 August 2026, the House of Assembly –

Ordered – That

(2) In accordance with section 24(1)(d) of the Integrity Commission Act 2009 (Tas), the Joint Standing Committee on Integrity inquire into and report upon the operation of the confidentiality provisions of the Integrity Commission Act 2009 (Tas), including, but not limited to, sections 11, 94, 98 and 100, with the following Terms of Reference:—

- (a) whether those provisions strike an appropriate balance between protecting the integrity of investigations, procedural fairness and public accountability;
- (b) the interaction between investigations conducted by the Integrity Commission and the statutory, administrative and convention-based obligations applying to Ministers, Members of Parliament, Heads of Agency, State Service employees and other public officers;
- (c) approaches adopted in other Australian jurisdictions to balance procedural fairness, confidentiality, public accountability and transparency in the work of integrity and anti-corruption bodies;
- (d) identifying any legislative amendments to improve transparency, public confidence and parliamentary accountability while maintaining appropriate protections for investigations and affected persons; and
- (e) any other matters incidental thereto.
