A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Statutory Holidays Act 2000*

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statutory Holidays Amendment (Central Coast Municipality) Act 2026*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on 1 January 2027.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Statutory Holidays Act 2000** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Section 3 amended (Interpretation)

Section 3(1) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting before the definition of *public notice* the following definition:

agreed day, in relation to a person who is employed by an employer to work in a municipal area that is not entitled under Schedule 1 to a statutory holiday for a show day, means –

- (a) a single day that is –
 - (i) a day other than a Saturday, Sunday or other statutory holiday; and
 - (ii) agreed by the employee and the employer as a statutory holiday for the employee; or
- (b) if no such agreement is reached between the employee and employer, the Friday following the first Thursday in May;

5. Schedule 1 amended (Statutory Holidays)

Schedule 1 to the Principal Act is amended by inserting after item 10 in Part 1 the following item:

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6. Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on the first anniversary of
the day on which it commences.
