

PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

POST OFFICE;

REPORT AND RETURNS FOR 1889.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



GENERAL POST OFFICE.

Hobart, June, 1890.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to submit herewith the usual annual Returns of the Post Office transactions for the year 1889, which, it will be seen, exhibit a steady increase of business over previous years.

Revenue and Expenditure.—The total collections on account of revenue for the year 1889 amounted to £51,268 9s. 5d., consisting of various items estimated as follows:—Postage, £35,630 18s. 6d.; revenue stamps, £10,232 8s. 5d.; and the balance, £5405 2s. 6d., fees, contributions, and reimbursements.

The number of adhesive stamps issued was 49,907,401; post cards, 150,018; embossed envelopes, 7020; registration envelopes, 1392, and the value of impressed stamps, £8797 1s.; in addition to which 5212 exchanges were allowed for spoilt impressed forms, value £207 0s. 11d.

Additional dies of various values have been obtained, and found of much convenience in stamping documents with amounts hitherto not provided for.

Mail Matter.—Mail matter circulated during the past year was as follows:—3,503,194 inland letters were despatched, an increase of 59,820 on the previous year; 1,200,140 ship letters were dealt with, showing an increase of 17,783 on the previous year; 651,706 packets were distributed, an increase of 52,785 on the previous year; 110,905 post cards were posted, an increase of 20,392; and it is estimated that 5,424,647 newspapers were circulated.

Of the number of letters and packets posted 630,715 were franked.

Dead Letter Branch.—22,419 unclaimed letters were dealt with.

Offices.—During the year 15 additional offices have been established. The total number at close of last year was 293, against 278 the previous year.

Number of miles of post roads at close of last year was 2868, and 826,510 miles were travelled during the year.

Inland Mails.—With the exception of a temporary disturbance caused by floods, the mails have been carried with commendable regularity. Advantage of the opening of the Scottsdale railway was taken to expedite the transit of the North-Eastern mails, and it is hoped that at no distant date additional improvement in that direction may be effected.

Postage on newspapers to a limited extent came into operation on the 1st January, 1889, and the estimated revenue therefrom has been fairly realized.

Money Orders.—During the past year 64,679 orders for £157,963 5s. 11d. were issued; 55,776 orders for £130,680 11s. 8d. were paid, and the commission collected £2059 5s., the respective increases being 6293 orders issued for £13,840 6s. 3d., orders paid, 6506 for £15,681 9s. 10d., and commission collected, £145 4s. 3d.

Postal Notes.—Arrangements were completed for the issue of postal notes, payable in Tasmania, South Australia, and Victoria, and promise to be largely used as a convenient mode of transmitting small sums of money. They consist of 14 varieties, viz.—1s., 1s. 6d., 2s., 2s. 6d., 3s., 3s. 6d., 4s., 4s. 6d., 5s., 7s. 6d., 10s., 10s. 6d., 15s., and 20s.

Post Office Savings Banks.—Deposits to the amount of £41,683 13s. 2d. were received during the year, upon which £1582 18s. 4d. for interest was allowed to depositors, and during the same period £39,369 9s. 10d. was withdrawn, leaving a balance of £51,988 15s. 10d. standing to credit of depositors, against £48,091 14s. 2d. at close of previous year—an increase of £3897 1s. 8d.

Buildings.—Several new country post offices are in course of erection, and additions to others authorised. It is anticipated that the erection of commodious offices at Strahan and Mount Zeehan will require prompt attention, as the business in those districts is advancing rapidly in consequence of the late mineral developments.

The proposed introduction of the inland and intercolonial parcel post system, together with the ever increasing general business of the department, will necessitate additional accommodation being provided for the chief office, Hobart, at an early date.

Inspection.—The appointment of an Inspector of Post Offices is now becoming a matter for serious consideration. It is believed that such an officer would be of much value to the Department, and render good service in checking irregularities between country stations, advising as to required mail routes, and in improving the general efficiency of inland stations.

The Staff.—Several officers were rendered incapable of attending to their duties through sickness, necessitating the extra attendance of those convalescent, who, I am pleased to report, have always exhibited a ready willingness to render any assistance in cases of emergency.

A comparative statement, showing the progress made by the Department from the year 1879 to 1889, is attached hereto for general information, and which possibly may prove of some interest.
