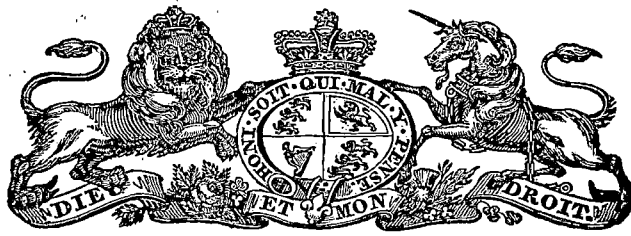

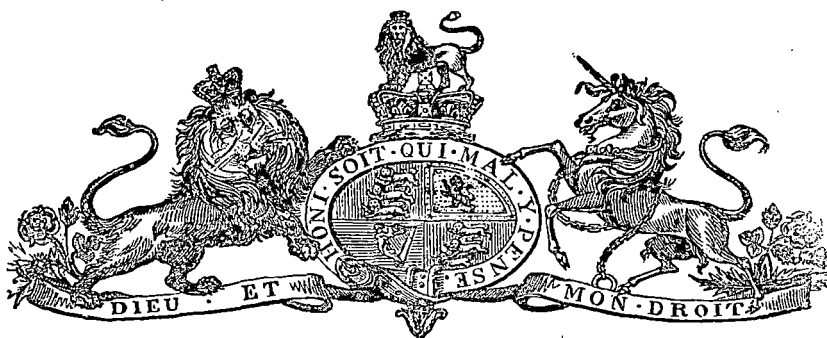

**GLENORA RAILWAY:**

**PETITION FROM NEW NORFOLK AS TO ROUTE.**

Presented by Mr. Watchorn, December 14, and ordered by the Council to be printed, December 18, 1883.



*The Honorable the President and Members of the Legislative Council, in Parliament assembled.*

The Petition of the undersigned Electors of the Electoral District of New Norfolk,

**RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH :**

THAT as the Government has decided on expending a large amount of money in constructing a Railway from South Bridgewater to Glenora along the Valley of the Derwent, and as a great difference of opinion exists with respect to proposed route of the said line, and also as to the proposed terminal station at Glenora, we respectfully submit to your consideration the following :—

- 1stly. That in our opinion the New Norfolk Station should be on the right bank of the Derwent, as nearly in the centre of the existing town as possible.
- 2ndly. That a single Railway bridge over the Derwent above New Norfolk will best serve the majority of the property holders in these districts.
- 3rdly. That the line should pass through Macquarie Plains, with a terminal station near Arundel, at a point which would admit of its future extension to Hamilton and the Ouse. By avoiding Webberley's Hill, keeping nearer the Derwent, the crossing at Fairydale may be reached, whence Hamilton, as in first proposal of Ministers.
- 4thly. That by dispensing with five Railway bridges over the rivers Derwent and Russell's Falls, and the tunnels near Bushy Park, a sum of £35,000 may be made available to deal with extraordinary obstacles met with in altered routes.
- 5thly. That this line would pass through a much greater extent of valuable land, and benefit a far greater number of property holders, than that proposed by Ministers.

Your Petitioners would therefore humbly pray that your Honorable House, before passing the Railway Policy of Ministers, will be pleased to take such measures for securing the wishes of your Petitioners as may be deemed advisable.

And your Petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
