CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT (LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS) BILL 2011

(Brought in by the Honourable Donald George Wing)

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Constitution Act 1934

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Constitution Amendment (Legislative Council Proceedings) Act 2011.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Constitution Act 1934** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Section 20 amended (Quorum of the Council)

Section 20 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting in subsection (1) "or her" after "his";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) ", exclusive of the President";
- (c) by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:
 - (3) A question on which there is an equality of votes passes in the negative.

5. Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on the ninetieth day from the day on which it commences.
