

Sir,

I HAVE the honor to submit the Annual Report of the Launceston Charitable Institution for the year ending 31st December, 1894.

Admissions and Discharges.

The daily average was—males, 152.78; females, 51.36, of whom 202.06 were chargeable to the Colonial Government and 2.08 to the Imperial Government.

Of the 46 deaths 8 were over 80 years and 2 over 90. Average age at death 73 years, the maximum age being 95 and the minimum 39.

Expenditure.—The gross expenditure for the year was £2319 2s. 9d., a reduction of £439 5s. 6d. on the year 1893. Net expenditure £2224 4s. 11d., or £413 15s. 6d. less than the previous year.

Annual cost per head £11 7s. $2\frac{1}{4}d$., and £10 17s. 10d. on gross and net expenditure respectively, as against £12 16s. 10d. and £12 5s. $7\frac{3}{4}d$. for the year 1893.

Towards the close of the year negotiations were opened up between the Government and the Launceston Benevolent Society with a view of placing the management of the institution in the hands of the latter. These were brought to a satisfactory conclusion, and the establishment passed from the control of the Government on the 31st December, an arrangement which will, doubtless, be to the advantage of all concerned.
