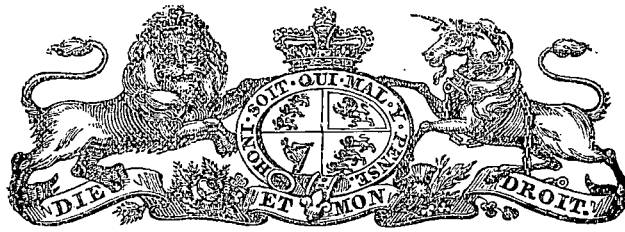

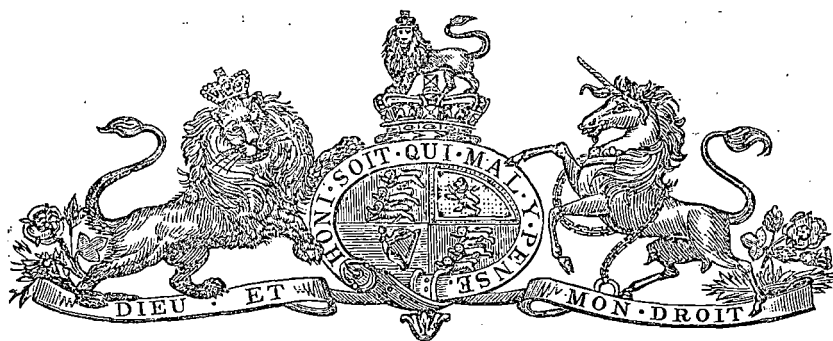

## MOUNT BISCHOFF PROVIDENT HOSPITAL.

### *THIRTEENTH Annual Report of the Mount Bischoff Provident Hospital for Year ended 31st December, 1893.*

Waratah, 24th January, 1894.

SIR,

THE Committee of the above Institution have much pleasure in submitting the Thirteenth Annual Report and Balance Sheet.

*Buildings and Improvements.*—The buildings are in a thorough state of repair. A new fence fronting the Hospital has been erected at a cost of £29 18s. 3d. The interior of the morgue has been fitted up with table, cupboards, &c., with sundry repairs to verandah and other places. Contract has also been let for painting the exterior of premises and interior of kitchen with two coats of paint, at a cost of £29 5s.

*Medical.*—During the year the Medical Officer, Dr. R. A. Brewis, has treated as outside patients 292 cases—viz., 128 males, 164 females—and 3 patients inside. No deaths during the year in the Hospital; the Medical Officer in his duties giving every satisfaction.

*Financial.*—The year has closed with a credit balance of £510 4s. 6d., against £626 11s. 7d. of last year; no subsidy being received from Government for 1893.

Kayser, Esq., Manager of the Mount Bischoff Company, from visitors to the mine; also the amount of £4 7s. 6d. from collection box in the Office of the Company.

*Committee.*—No change in the *personnel* has taken place during the year. Mr. A. A. Littler was unanimously re-elected President, Mr. C. Sheedy re-elected Vice-President, Mr. George Dakin re-elected Treasurer.
