

**CLAUSE NOTES**  
*Traffic Amendment (Personal Mobility Devices) Bill 2021*

Clause 1	<b>Short title</b>  This clause sets out the Short Title.
Clause 2	<b>Commencement</b>  This clause provides for the Act to commence on the day of proclamation.
Clause 3	<b>Principal Act</b>  This clause provides that, in this Act, the Principal Act is the <i>Traffic Act 1925</i> .
Clause 4	<b>Section 41B amended (Power of police officer to temporarily confiscate personal mobility devices, wheeled recreational devices and wheeled toys)</b>  This clause applies existing police powers for wheeled recreational devices to personal mobility devices.
Clause 5	<b>Section 41CA inserted (Declaration of road for use by personal mobility devices)</b>  This clause sets out the power and means for road authorities to specify roads speed limited to 50km/h or below that personal mobility devices can access.
Clause 6	<b>Repeal of Act</b>  This clause is consistent with legislative practices to repeal amendment Acts as the provisions are incorporated to the Principal Act on commencement.
