Clause I	Short title
	This clause sets out the Short Title.
Clause 2	Commencement
	This clause provides for the Act to commence on the day of proclamation.
Clause 3	Principal Act
	This clause provides that, in this Act, the Principal Act is the <i>Traffic</i> Act 1925.
Clause 4	Section 41B amended (Power of police officer to temporarily confiscate personal mobility devices, wheeled recreational devices and wheeled toys)
	This clause applies existing police powers for wheeled recreational devices to personal mobility devices.
Clause 5	Section 41CA inserted (Declaration of road for use by personal mobility devices)
	This clause sets out the power and means for road authorities to specify roads speed limited to 50km/h or below that personal mobility devices can access.
Clause 6	Repeal of Act
	This clause is consistent with legislative practices to repeal amendment Acts as the provisions are incorporated to the Principal Act on commencement.
