Inquiry into the Recent Developments Relating to Government Policy on Poker Machine Harm Minimisation

On Tuesday 11 August 2026, the Legislative Council Sessional Committee Government Administration A resolved to appoint a sub-committee to conduct a short inquiry into recent developments relating to government policy on poker machine harm minimisation, including:

1. The Tasmanian Government-commissioned Deloitte Report, *Social and Economic Impact of Electronic Gaming Machine (EGM) Reform use in Tasmania* (December 2025), including the Government's response and utilisation of the report
2. The Government's 'harm minimisation' measures announced on 23 January 2026, including:
 - a. their origin, and
 - b. policy work and evidence informing the announced measures; and
3. Any other matters incidental thereto.
