

TELEGRAPH POST DEPARTMENT. AND

General Post Office, Hobart, 12th May, 1899.

I HAVE the honour to place before you a Report on the Post and Telegraph Department of Tasmania for the year 1898, showing its receipts and expenditure and the general working of its several branches. I am pleased to say that the receipts for 1898 exceed those of the previous year by £7653 9s. 9d. For the purposes of comparison the figures for 1897 are shown in brackets.

Revenue.—The amount collected under this head was £92,667 7s. $4\frac{1}{2}d$. [£85,013 17s. $7\frac{1}{2}d$.], thus apportioned:—Postage, £57,975 8s. 9d. [£52,847 12s. 1d.]; revenue stamps, £8000; money order commission, £3365 19s. 6d. [£2971 7s. 11d.]; profit earned under item Savings Banks, £1249 14s. 2d. [£1083 7s. 11d.]; private boxes, mail bags, fines, &c., £875 9s. 6d. [£762 0s. 1d.]; poundage on postal notes, £359 15s. $6\frac{1}{2}d$. [£2921 9s. $10\frac{1}{2}d$.]; telephone protein £2328 7s. 6d. [£2926 11s. 0.4] £17,002 12s. 5d. [£15,529 18s. 9d.]; telephone rentals, £3838 7s. 6d. [£3526 11s. 0d.].

The number of stamps sold were:—Adhesive, 7864,740; post cards, 272,916; embossed envelopes, 15,216; registration envelopes, 1512; letter cards, 2952; and value of impressed, £14,606 15s. 2d.; 9750 exchanges were made, representing £196 9s. 6d. This latter amount

did not enhance the revenué.

The above shows an increase in the aggregate of stamps, post cards, and embossed and registration envelopes of 692,796.

A set of stamps bearing views of Tasmanian scenery is in course of preparation, and is expected

to be ready for issue to the public towards the end of this year.

The expenditure amounted to £73,248 8s. 10d. [£65,268 9s. 7d.], made up of salaries and allowances, £34,830 14s. 10d. [£30,814 12s. 10d.]; conveyance of mails, £26,291 15s. 5d. [£24,278 1s. 0d.]; miscellaneous, £4045 9s. 3d. [£3476 15s. 3d.]; cable subsidies, £2060 12s. 9d. [£2095 3s. 1d.]; additions, repairs, and maintenance of lines, £6019 16s. 7d. [£4603 17s. 5d.]

Parcels Post.—9801 inland parcels were posted during the year 1898, an increase of 1406 over 1897, and 2331 ship parcels were posted, an increase of 272 over 1897.

There was also collected £3008 1s. 3d. on account of Customs dues on 13,549 packets and parcels, valued at £16,501 5s. 3d., which were received from the United Kingdom and Colonies, which amount went to credit of Customs Department.

Mail Matter.—Under this head 5,126,612 [4,605,542] inland letters were despatched, an increase of 521,070 on previous year; 3,988,243 [3,300,964] ship letters received and despatched, an increase of 687,279; 281,944 [257,878] post cards; 1,477,871 [2,278,082] packets were dealt with; and it is estimated that 5,574,850 [5,095,792] newspapers passed through the office. Of these letters and packets 1,146,598 [1,059,507] were franked, and consequently did not contribute to the

The method of counting letters for two months only of the year for statistical purposes was adopted with respect to Intercolonial and Foreign correspondence in 1898, and is about to be brought into effect with respect to Inland correspondence during the current year. This will, it is surmised, reduce the work of our Country Postmasters and Staff Officials, and conduce to the more efficient working of the Department.

Dead Letter Branch.—56,147 [65,996] unclaimed letters (765 registered) were disposed of, inclusive of some 1500 [1800] "special request."

Post Offices opened during 1898.—Thirteen.

Post Offices closed .- Two.

Number of Miles of Post Roads at end of year, 2667 [2718], and 1,407,351 [1,272,545] miles were travelled during the year.

Inland Mail Service.—Very satisfactorily carried out, contractors giving little or no trouble to the Department.

Intercolonial Mail Service.—The contract is being very satisfactorily performed by the Union Steamship Company.

Money Orders.—During the year 121,738 [102,775] orders for £244,971 9s. 11d. [£204,510 10s. 9d.] were issued; 228,121 [209,518] for £330,288 16s. 9d. [£307,611 15s. 4d.] were paid. The commission collected on issues was £2949 16s. 3d. [£2461 5s. 6d.]

Post Office Savings Banks.—£134,308 6s. 5d. [£106,665 16s. 2d.] was received as deposit during the year, including £4698 17s. 2d. [£4025 1s. 5d.] apportioned to the depositors as interest; £103,080 3s. 3d. [£84,804 17s 10d.] was withdrawn, leaving a balance of £186,978 9s. 8d. [£155,750 6s. 6d.] to credit of investors; 4517 accounts were opened, 3073 were closed, and 10,607 remained open at close of year, as against 9163 in 1897.

Postal Notes.—50,353 [41,435] were sold, aggregating £15,530 8s. 5d. [£12,805 9s. 6d.] in amount, and 48,521 [42,445] were paid, aggregating £15,311 10s. 7d. [£13,448 0s. 5d.] in amount.

Cable Subsidies.—Tasmania's liability was £2003 1s 6d., as against £2045 3s. 1d. for the previous year.

The large increase of work in all branches of the Department, more especially at the Head Office in Hobart, points to the urgent necessity that exists for a larger building to be used as a General Post Office; and I trust this matter will at no distant date receive favourable consideration at your hands.
