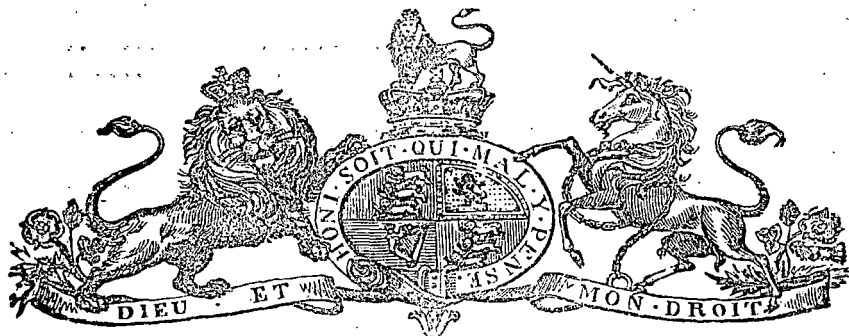

PUBLIC BUILDINGS:

REPORT AND ESTIMATE OF COST, 1877.

Return to an Order of the Council dated November 8, 1876.

Presented, and ordered by the Council to be printed, January 24, 1877.



ESTIMATES of the probable Cost of Repairs, &c. required to be done at the various Public Buildings and Institutions during 1877.

Voted for 1876.

Queen's Asylum for Destitute Children, New Town.

£100 Repairs and Alterations to Buildings £500
 (Re-shingling roofs, spouting, and other works, which have been postponed for some years.)

New Town Pauper Establishment for Females.

£50 Repairs and Alterations to Buildings £100
 (This sum is required to provide for new closets, general repairs, painting, &c.)

Hospital for the Insane, New Norfolk.

£150 Repairs and Alterations to Buildings and Fences £200
 (This amount will be needed for general repairs; in addition to which further provision will be required for extra sleeping accommodation if application is authorised.)

General Hospital, Hobart Town.

£200 Repairs and Alterations to Buildings £200
 (This amount will be required for general repairs to buildings, Liverpool-street.)

General Hospital, Launceston.

£120 and Repairs and Alterations to Buildings £150
 £100 Sup- (For general repairs to buildings and fences.)
 plementary.

Cascade Pauper Establishment for Males.

£70 Repairs and Alterations to Buildings £150

Brickfields Pauper Establishment for Males.

£75 Repairs and Alterations to Buildings, and erection of new Kitchen £300

Launceston Pauper Establishment for Males.

£50 Repairs and Alterations to Buildings £50

Police.

£400 Construction of and Repairs to Police Buildings generally, and Furniture for same £500

Gaols.

£450 Alterations and Repairs to Gaols £500

Main Line of Road.

General Repairs only £2500
 (Tolls estimated at £1600. To be voted, £900.)
