

BYE-LAW TO REGULATE THE SALE OF LATHS, SHINGLES, &c.

Laid upon the Table by the Clerk of the House, October 3, 1876, and ordered by the House to be printed.



CITY OF HOBART TOWN.

A BYE-LAW to regulate the Sale of Laths, Shingles, and Sawn Colonial Hardwood Timber.

Whereas by virtue of the powers conferred upon the Municipal Council of the City of Hobart Town by "The Hobart Town Corporation Act," 21 V. No. 14, and of every power enabling them in that behalf, the said Municipal Council is authorised to make Bye-laws (inter alia) for prohibiting every kind of fraudulent device and practice in relation to the sale of marketable commodities:

And whereas considerable inconvenience and loss is experienced and sustained in the sale of Laths, Shingles, and Sawn Colonial Hardwood Timber, by the irregular manner in which such sales are effected in the absence of any fixed standard to regulate the same:

And whereas it is desirable to establish uniformity in the quantity and measurement by which the said commodities shall be sold in the said City or shipped therefrom, and to define the same accordingly:

Be it therefore ordained by the said Council that from and after the date of this Bye-law coming into operation the said commodities, enumerated in the following Schedule marked A, shall be sold according to the quantities and measurement therein contained; and the same shall be the only lawful standard by which the quantities and measurements of such commodities shall be regulated and sold.

And every person selling any of the said commodities otherwise than according to the quantities or dimensions or measurements as specified in the said Schedule shall, upon conviction for every such offence, forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds.

Passed by the Municipal Council of the City of Hobart Town the 2nd day of October, 1876, a majority of the said Council being present, and the Common Seal of the Corporation affixed.
