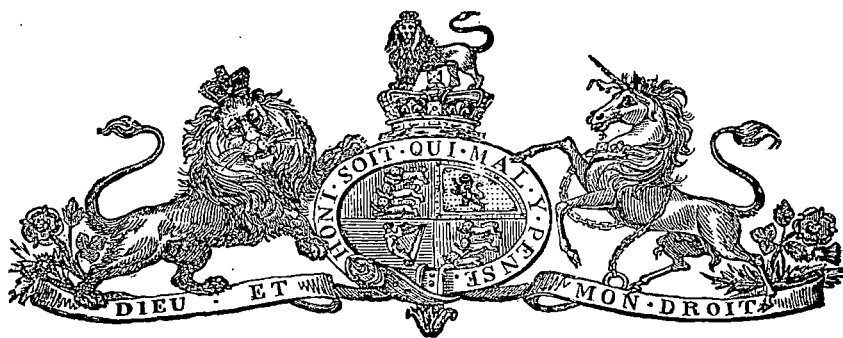

REGULATIONS UNDER "THE GOLD FIELDS REGULATION ACT, 1870."

By virtue of "The Gold Fields Regulation Act, 1870," His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth make the Regulations following; to take effect on and from this date:—

Ordinary Claims under Miners' Rights for mining purposes.

85. Any person being the holder of a miner's right shall be entitled to hold for mining purposes a single alluvial claim not exceeding one quarter of an acre; and any number of persons not exceeding ten, being the holders of miners' rights, shall be entitled to hold for mining purposes an united alluvial claim not exceeding one quarter of an acre for each person: Provided that every claim single or united shall, where practicable, be marked off in the form of a square. Extent of Alluvial Claim.

And any person being the holder of a miner's right shall be entitled to hold for mining purposes a single quartz claim not exceeding 20 yards in length, on the supposed course of the reef, by a width not exceeding 100 yards on each side of such course; and any number of persons not exceeding ten, being the holders of miners' rights, shall be entitled to hold for mining purposes an united quartz claim not exceeding 20 yards for each person along the course of the reef by 100 yards on each side of such course. All quartz claims shall, where practicable, be in the form of a rectangular parallelogram. Extent of Quartz Claim.

86. Whenever land alienated under the provisions of "The Waste Lands Act" shall be resumed for mining purposes under Section 54 of the said Act, at the instance or upon the application of any person discovering gold thereon, such person shall have a preferential right to such claim thereon as the Gold Fields Regulations shall authorise. Preferential right when alienated land resumed.

87. Regulations 8 and 9, made by the Governor in Council dated the ninth day of April, 1878, and Regulation 83, made by the Governor in Council dated the third day of February, 1879, are hereby repealed. Repeal.
