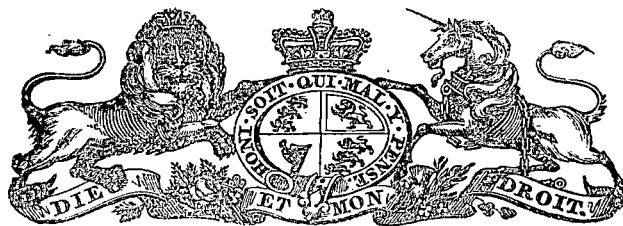

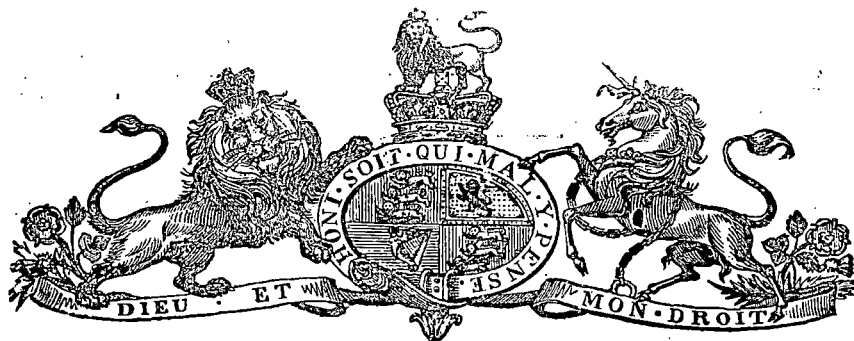

REPORT of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL, 1874.

IN meeting the Subscribers with a very satisfactory balance sheet, the Trustees would draw especial attention to the increase in the number of Annual Subscribers from the labouring classes, and also to the fact that a sum of £20 has been subscribed by the Shearers alone. These are matters for congratulation, as it is mainly for the welfare of these persons, their wives and families, that the Hospital is maintained.

The Hospital Buildings have been placed in thorough repair, whitewashed, &c. during the year, thereby adding considerably to the health and comfort of the inmates.

A sum of £63 has been judiciously expended in bedding, blankets, and other Hospital clothing greatly needed. These were procured from Hobart Town on the tender of Mr. Mather, at very reasonable rates, and give unqualified satisfaction.

Mr. and Mrs. Raiker still evince great zeal in the performance of their duties as Superintendent and Matron.

The thanks of the Subscribers and Trustees are due to the Medical Officer, Dr. Valentine; also to the Clergy for their frequent visits.
