A BILL FOR

**An Act to postpone the repeal of certain regulations
and to rescind and revoke certain enactments**

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Repeal of Regulations
Postponement and Rescission Act 2004*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which this Act
receives the Royal Assent.

Postponement of repeals

3. (1) The repeal of the regulations specified in Schedule 1
that, but for this section, was to have been effected on

1 January 2005 under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992* is postponed until 1 January 2006.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply so as to prevent the repeal of any regulations specified in Schedule 1 at any time before 1 January 2006.

Administration of Act

4. Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990* –

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Environment and Planning; and
- (b) the department responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Primary Industries, Water and Environment.

Expiry

5. This Act expires on 2 January 2006.

Statutory Rules rescinded

6. The Statutory Rules specified in Schedule 2 are rescinded.

Statutory Rules revoked

7. The Statutory Rules specified in Schedule 3 are revoked.
