

## Charitable Recycler Rebate Program Eligibility

### **Ms ROSOL question to MINISTER for ENVIRONMENT**

My question is on behalf of Ingrid O'Neill, Tresca Community Centre, Exeter. Ingrid reports rising waste disposal costs from unsuitable donations and illegal dumping. As a small organisation with limited funding, the cost of disposing of this waste is difficult to cover. Tresca wants to register as a charitable recycler so they can access the rebate that helps cover this cost, however, they don't have deductible gift recipient status and the process for obtaining it is proving lengthy. This excludes them from applying for charitable recycler status, despite being a community organisation struggling to dispose of the volume of unsuitable donations they receive.

Ingrid has sought clarification on this requirement, but is yet to hear back. Will you review the Charitable Recycler Rebate Program eligibility criteria to help Tresca and similar organisations access financial support to dispose of the growing level of waste they deal with?
