

SALMON AND TROUT REGULATIONS.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



GOVERNMENT NOTICE.

No. 209.

Chief Secretary's Office, 10th June, 1886.

The Governor in Council has been pleased, in accordance with the provisions of "An Act to make better provision for regulating the Close Season for Salmon and Trout," 49 Victoria, No. 28, to make the following Regulations:—

That fishing for Salmon and Trout, with rod and line only, be fixed for the season 1886-7, as follows:—

- 1. In the River Derwent from its mouth to the southern side of the Bridge at New Norfolk, and in the River Huon from its mouth to Mosquito Point, from 1st August, 1886, to 30th April following, both days inclusive.
- 2. In all rivers emptying into Bass' Straits from 1st October, 1886, to 30th April following, both days inclusive.
- 3. In all other rivers, including those portions of the Rivers Derwent and Huon not previously referred to, from 1st September, 1886, to 30th April following, both days inclusive.
