NEW TOWN FARM.

26th March, 1892.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to forward herewith the Annual Report and Account Current for the New Town Farm for the year 1891.

The gross receipts for the year amounted to £932 1s. 1d.; the expenditure for that period was £856 10s. 7d., leaving a balance in favour of the Farm of £75 10s. 6d.

During the year the usual farming operations were performed and crops grown, and the supply of milk produced was up to that of former years.

The live stock on the Farm on the 31st December, 1891, was as follows:—5 horses, 1 bull, 31 cows, 3 calves, and 24 pigs.

All the Farm work was performed satisfactorily.
