


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

REPORT OF ENGINEER-IN-CHIEF, (INCLUDING REPORTS OF
ENGINEER OF ROADS AND GOVERNMENT ARCHITECT).

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to submit my Annual Report on Public Works, and in continuation of Paper No. 55, House of Assembly Journals, 1887.

RAILWAYS.

Scottsdale Line.

The earthworks, culverts, and bridges are all practically complete. The one or two slips in cuttings now give no further trouble, and the subsidence of ground under the large bank near Launceston also appears to have ceased. The large amount of construction in concrete work is standing exceedingly well. The permanent way has been laid to Golconda station, a distance of 34 miles from Launceston, thus leaving 13 miles to complete to Scottsdale. This is being pushed on, the material trains being now taken through the tunnel by a small engine purchased by the contractors for the purpose of expediting the work.

The time for completion of this contract expired on 1st March last, when contractors applied for an extension of from nine to twelve months, setting forth various grounds, upon some of which they were considered to be so far entitled to consideration as to justify my recommending, and your approving, of the shorter time (nine months) being granted. Great and special efforts will have to be made by them, as at the key of the whole work—the tunnel—it is not expected that excavation will be completed before end of June, and the lining has then to be done throughout the whole length of 770 yards. I had hoped that the rock might prove to be sufficiently sound to save lining the whole of the work, but after examination of its rotten condition in some portions, and finding in the sounder parts a tendency towards sliding on the inclined greasy beds, I decided that for proper security the whole tunnel should be lined.

The erection of station buildings up to Lilydale is well advanced, and contracts are ready for the remainder of the buildings.

Derwent Valley Line.

Tenders for completion between Plenty and Glenora were received on 20th July, 1887, and that of Mr. R. C. Patterson, at £27,441 4s. 6d. was accepted,—this amount including a repayment on account of materials, £1445 17s. 7d., and on account of plant, royalties, &c., £3831 17s. 2d.; the time for completion being 18 months.

Subsequently a bonus payment of £2000 was agreed upon, the contractor being bound to complete within 12 months in lieu of the original 18 months; but this arrangement was afterwards modified by annulling the payment of the bonus, and allowing the contractor the use of plant upon payment of £500, instead of the original arrangement for purchase of same, the contractor being still bound to complete within the 12 months. Work under the contract has been performed in a satisfactory manner, and, with the advantage of an exceptionally fine season for the work, will no doubt be finished within the agreed time.

The Departmental work was authorised to be continued as far as the commencement of Mr. Patterson's contract at the Plenty, and was satisfactorily performed at reasonable cost.

The section from Bridgewater to New Norfolk was opened for public traffic on 1st September last, and handed over to the Traffic Department after dwelling accommodation had been increased and additional work done for effecting this partial opening. Subsequently a foot-bridge was required and provided over the Main Line Railway at Bridgewater Junction, and further engine-shed room is now under consideration.

A further section from New Norfolk to Plenty was opened on 1st March last; and all work beyond that to Macquarie Plains station is now practically complete, including, of course, the No. 2 bridge.

At No. 3 bridge the piers are finished, girders all launched over same, and are being rapidly fixed in position. This being done, and deck laid, there will only remain some two miles of permanent way and Glenora sidings to complete Mr. Patterson's contract.

The designs for the bridges have been subjected to considerable criticism, but being erected they will speak for themselves, and prove both solid and enduring.

Requisitions have been made for dwellings for workmen, and these are now being erected, with remainder of the station buildings.

North-Western and Fingal Lines.

The various additional works sanctioned by Parliament are being carried out by the Engineer of Permanent Way under the Manager.

NEW LINES.—(49 VICT. NO. 41.)

Tenders for the Formby-Ulverstone Line and for the Green Ponds Line are now being invited.

Formby and Ulverstone Extension.

Deviations have been made from the Parliamentary plan, by which greatly improved approaches by railway to the Leith-on-Forth station have been obtained. At Ulverstone also the Line has been altered from Button's Creek and the Esplanade, and an excellent station ground has been obtained in a central position, with a better get-away for future extension. The township property has proved rather costly to purchase, but I think the alteration was a desirable one.

The proposed fixed bridge over the River Forth has been altered to provide for opening spans, and this determined me in designing the work for the whole bridge in a more permanent character. The Don River bridge, although remaining as a fixed bridge, has also been designed to be of as permanent a character as it is possible to make it. Any excess on the rough approximate estimate of cost for the vote will be largely due to the altered character of the bridges.

Green Ponds Line.

Preliminary consultations have been held with the Manager of the Main Line Railway re the junction arrangements at Brighton station, and the actual junction decided upon at some point on the south side of Jordan bridge instead of on north side. To effect this it is proposed to construct an independent bridge for the Government traffic.

Chudleigh Line.

It will save expense and inconvenience in working if this Line is continued alongside the Mersey Railway to the present Chudleigh Road station, and I have therefore provided for such connection. The distance is about three-quarters of a mile.

Sorell Line.

I have lately accompanied the Manager over the Line, and considered the question of terminal accommodation. I believe he is of opinion that a railway wharf running out into the bay at Bellerive from the site of proposed station there, is all that is required for any probable traffic, and I presume he will make his report to you thereon.

RAILWAY SURVEYS.

The surveys from Kimberley *via* Sheffield to Western Railway on the North-West Coast, and from Antill Ponds to Longford, are still left incomplete from want of necessary funds. The Scottsdale and Ringarooma survey has been finished since date of last Report, and a satisfactory line for such difficult country has been obtained.

I would recommend to your notice the desirability of having a contract survey made from a point on the above survey, where most practicable, for a railway to Branxholm and Moorina, so as to tap the agricultural and mineral country in that direction, and thus place the Government in possession of full information before actual construction beyond Scottsdale is determined upon.

HARBOURS AND RIVER WORKS.

Work on River Tamar under the Marine Board has been satisfactorily progressing.

Work at the Mersey bar has been checked by difficulties with the steam-dredge, which, I trust, will soon be removed. There appears to be a hard skin of shingle over the sandy bar, and when this is all removed the tidal action will materially assist the dredging by scour. Working surveys have been made for determining and testing the required work. Large additions have been made to the wharf accommodation at Formby, and further works are still in progress.

Work at Emu Bay has progressed satisfactorily, the new work having been extended 150 feet or thereabouts since last Report, making the extension from old work 260 feet.

Work has also been done or is in hand at minor ports.

ROADS AND BUILDINGS.

I append Reports of Engineer of Roads and Architect, and, as last year, have the honor to commend to your notice the suggestions *re* the swing-bridge at Bridgewater.

REPORT OF ENGINEER OF ROADS.

29th May, 1888.

SIR,

SINCE the date of my last year's Report on the Roads and other Works of the Colony, I have to report that there have been added to the constructed roads 13 miles of main road, 123 miles of branch roads, 116 miles of roads opened up and cleared from Waste Lands Funds, 21 new bridges, and 8 jetties. For the past few years, owing to the mineral discoveries on the West Coast in gold, silver-lead ore, and tin, the want of tracks and roads between Macquarie Harbour and the Pieman River has been impressed upon the attention of the Government, and as a consequence large bodies of labourers have been and are now busily employed in opening up new lines of road to the various mineral centres, as well as continuing those already cleared and formed in the past few years. At present active operations are going on to complete the overland track from Hobart to the Linda Gold Fields; and the labour of cutting and clearing the track through dense forest and scrub land, as well as bridging the various rivers, is for the most part completed up to the King River, that flows at foot of the eastern slopes of the Great West Coast Range.

The road from Long Bay, Macquarie Harbour, to Lynch's Creek and the Linda, as well as to the Honeysuckle Plains, has been greatly improved and fitted for traffic during the past few months.

From Reminé (Trial Harbour), *viâ* the Old Orient Tin Claim, a road is being cleared and made good to the silver-lead finds at Mount Zeehan. This line of road will also be continued in the direction of Mount Sedgwick, so as to utilise the gap in Main Range as part of the Main Trunk Road from Hobart, *viâ* Marlborough and the Linda, to Mount Heemskirk.

From the present settlement at Macquarie Harbour, *viâ* the trunk road to Lynch's Creek, by utilising Moore's track to the Honeysuckle Plains a good safe inland road to Trial Harbour can be made, and the present dangerous road across the mouths of the Little and Great Henty Rivers, as well as the dangerous beach track can be done away with as the main line of communication between Long Bay and Trial Harbour. The present beach road must always be a dangerous track to travel, as the Henty Rivers are constantly being bar-bound, and their channels are charged after every flood, and, except in calm weather, the part of the road along the beach is risky and treacherous to travel.

That portion of the West Coast Range from the King River to the mouth of the Gordon River, comprising Mounts Darwin, Sorell, and Jukes, will be opened up by the main trunk road from Kelly's Basin *viâ* Flanagan's Creek to junction with the Marlborough through road, at the crossing of the King River in vicinity of the Linda. Owing to the dense nature of the undergrowth and size of the forest timber on the West Coast, the preliminary expenses of cutting tracks and making roads to serve the various mineral finds must of necessity be heavy, and the results as a money value disappointing. The climate is for the most part of the year wet, and the rainfall heavy and frequent, and the whole country saturated with wet. Traffic with pack-horses, except on the cut tracks, is impossible; feed for the pack-horses must be imported, as there are no native grasses for stock. The traffic is of necessity confined to the cut tracks, which soon become, from constant use, ribbons of mud. As in most instances provisions and tools have to be carried on men's backs to the various claims and mineral explorations, the hardships attendant on the West Coast claims are many and severe. The works done under the Department during the past few years have much reduced these hardships and hindrances to mining ventures, but with every new find similar difficulties arise, and complaints and discontent break out afresh.

The number of contracts let by the Roads and Bridges Branch of the Public Works during the past year are 410. These contracts are exclusive of the works done on the West Coast under the Department.

Great efforts have been made during the present summer to get out works under the Acts passed last Session, and since January of this year 250 contracts have been let in the various districts, many of which have been satisfactorily completed, and the rest are well in hand. These, with the particulars now in course of preparation, have kept the District Inspectors fully employed, not only in taking particulars for new work, but in supervising same often at long distances apart, as well as in laying out pioneer works under Waste Lands Funds.

During the past four years there have been added to the length of main roads 64 miles, to the branch roads 425 miles, and under the Waste Lands Funds 146 miles of road have been cleared and made passable; 85 new bridges have been built, and 46 jetties erected.

In respect to these new jetties, once they are erected and out of the hands of the contractors there is no provision or authority to look after or maintain these important and useful additions to the navigation of our estuaries and rivers, and, as an absolute consequence, many will after a few more years have to be re-built or abandoned as useless.*

Previous to 1885 no annual provision had been made for the repairs and maintenance of main road bridges and other large bridges over important streams on branch roads and other important lines of communication. For the repairs of stone bridge over the Coal River at Richmond, Prosser's River Bridge, Orford, and Main Road Bridge at Brighton, special provision was made barely in time to save these structures from total ruin.

The other important bridges were left without repairs during many years, not only on the branch and trunk lines of road, but on the main roads, even to the smallest culverts, so that when in 1885 the sum of £1600 was set aside for repairs in the Maintenance Schedule, only those bridges that were in the worst state could be dealt with during that year.

In the next year's Maintenance Schedule, 1886, the sum of £1500 was voted for bridge repairs, and several of the most important bridges were overhauled and put into substantial repair; viz.—bridge over the Meander, Deloraine; bridge over the Mersey, Latrobe; bridge over the Huon River, Victoria; bridge on Main Road, O'Brien's Bridge; Hobler's Bridge and Cataract Bridge over South Esk, Launceston. The sum set down in last year's maintenance, £750, has been far too small to meet even the most urgent requirements, as many of the small bridges and culverts on the Main (Hobart) Road are in a dangerous state from old age, decay, and past neglect.

In my last year's Report I brought under notice the dangerous state of the Main Road Bridge at Bridgewater. I have most respectfully to again call attention to the absolutely insecure and unsound condition of this bridge. Most of the piles and main timbers of the original bridge have been eaten away, or are destroyed by dry-rot and decay, and the present and only support to the bridge are the piles and timbers put in to shore up the bays of the bridge about four years since. These were intended only for temporary use, and have fulfilled their duty, so that a total collapse of the bridge may occur at any moment. The Public Works Department have called for tenders for the piles and principal timbers of the new bridge, as well as for the screw-piles, so that work can be commenced without loss of time as soon as the funds requisite for the completion of this bridge are voted. In 1883 the sum of £10,000 was voted towards the erection of this bridge, and in 1885 a further sum of £4000 was voted, and as the total estimate of the bridge is £27,000, another sum nearly equal to the money already granted will have to be devoted to this work. In dealing with supplies for the erection of this most important bridge, the question whether, as at present, a swing-bridge is to be provided for the passage of steamers trading to New Norfolk, or the level of bridge is to be raised so that vessels by lowering their funnels and mast in future shall pass under the bridge spans, should be definitely settled before the new bridge is commenced.

With the system of swing or draw-bridges a serious liability and possibility of frightful loss of life must always be calculated upon and provided against, and, notwithstanding the most vigilant care and immunity for years from accident, a change due to official routine or to illness or accident may lead up to a national calamity.

As the new railway along the Derwent Valley must be a most serious competitor to any river traffic, and as there is but one steam-vessel trading to New Norfolk at this time in the trade to which the swing-bridge system is necessary, no time could be more favourable than the present by legislation to do away with the hideous uncertainty that the swing-bridge system entails on the passage of trains across the Derwent River at this point. Ample provision for the small, handy steamers that are now engaged in the river trade can be made under the new bridge, provided the swing-bridge is done away with.
