Also 1s. was deducted from each of the under-mentioned Libraries:—Campbell Town, Deloraine, Green Ponds, Glenora, Hamilton-on-Forth, Longford, Mount Bischoff Mechanics' Institute, New Norfolk, Oatlands, Richmond, Scottsdale, Sorell, Westbury, and Wynyard.
