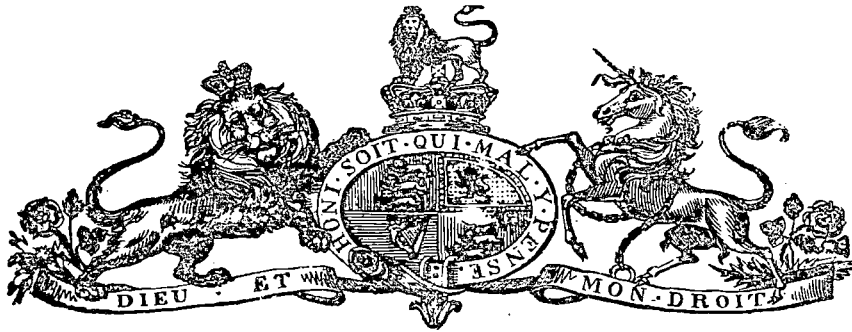

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to furnish the usual Annual Returns and Report on the working of the Electric Telegraph Department for the year ending the 31st December, 1879.

A comparison of the Returns with those of 1878 gives the following results :—

1. The gross receipts for 1878 were £12,144 3s. 10d., and 69,197 messages. For 1879 were £10,785 1s. 7d., and 70,189 messages, being a decrease of £1359 2s. 3d., and an increase of 992 messages.

2. A decrease on Tasmanian fees paid into the Treasury of £51 9s. 9d. arising thus :—Increase on Inter-Tasmanian business, £141 17s. 6d. : decrease on Intercolonial and European business, £193 7s. 3d.

3. Fees paid to Submarine Cable Company show a decrease of £1022 15s. 2d.

4. Fees paid to other Colonies on account of Intercolonial and European business show a decrease of £284 17s. 4d.

A comparative statement of the Receipts for the last five years is also furnished.

The following extensions have been completed during the year ; viz.—Geeves Town to Southport, 32 miles ; and Longford to Cressy, 7 miles. Total, 39 miles, and 3 new Stations.

The decrease in the receipts as compared with 1878 may, I think, be attributed in a great measure to the depression in Intercolonial trade which existed, and also made itself felt in a corresponding manner in the local traffic. A comparison of the receipts for the first quarter of 1880 with the corresponding period of 1879 shows, however, an increase of £240 in Inter-Tasmanian business, but a decrease on Intercolonial gross receipts of £223. I venture to suggest that the present cable rates are too high and almost prohibitory, and that a reduction therein would not only prove a boon to the general public but most likely tend to bring increased traffic and revenue. The increase of postal facilities between Tasmania and the adjoining Colonies also point to the advisability of reducing the cable rates to induce the public to make a more general use of cable communication.

The Submarine Cable between Tasmania and Victoria has worked uninterruptedly and well during the year.

The arrangement by which the Low Heads Station is worked by the Eastern Extension Telegraph Company's staff at that place continues to give satisfaction.

I am pleased to be able to report that, as a whole, the lines have, with one exception, worked more satisfactorily during the past year. The exception I refer to is the North West Coast Line, the frequent interruptions to which cause both annoyance and inconvenience, and is to be attributed to the exposed situation and the heavily timbered character of the country through which the line passes ; also the premature decay of the poles and the corrosion of the wire near the sea. As this is a very important section, I strongly recommend that measures be taken to have it better cleared and put in substantial order ; and would also suggest a larger gauge of wire on the coast portion, as the small-sized wire soon deteriorates by exposure to the action of the salt atmosphere.

In regard to "Maintenance," tenders were lately invited on a plan which it was hoped would place the services of a line repairer at every or every other Station, at a reasonable rate, so as to enable repairs to be effected promptly, but the result has not been altogether satisfactory ; and I am still of the opinion expressed in my Report for 1878 that it would be better to contract for the repair of the line in sections of 35 to 40 miles, the contractor to reside near the centre of each section, and that an efficient Inspector be employed who would be constantly traversing the various lines.

The alterations lately effected in the present building have so far given satisfaction to the general public and enabled me better to systematise the work ; but still the accommodation is far from being sufficient or what it ought to be in a Head Office, and I trust the time is not far distant when better and more convenient accommodation may be provided for such an important branch of the public service as the Electric Telegraph Department.
