

## CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL:

REPORT FOR 1880.

Laid upon the Table by the Colonial Treasurer, and ordered by the House to be printed, July 19, 1881.



REPORT of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL, 1880.

The Trustees congratulate the subscribers upon the favourable Report now read by the Treasurer, showing a balance to this date (7th February, 1881,) in favour of the Hospital funds of £266 10s. 8d. This includes the supplementary aid by Government to 31st December, 1880.

- 2. Although the number of out-door Patients (274) treated during the past year is large, there is a decrease in the number of in-door Patients (43), which may be attributed in some measure to the introduction of more stringent rules as to the supply of medical comforts. However this may be, your Trustees are convinced the decrease is only temporary; and the Hospital has really been growing in public estimation since the introduction of the new rules, as may be seen by the large sum of £40 received during the year from Patients and Ticket-holders.
  - 3. Of cases treated, 3 have died, 2 remain for treatment, and 38 have been discharged.
- 4. Mr. and Mrs. Saunders continue to afford the Treasurer great aid in collecting the smaller subscriptions, having paid in a sum of £9 11s. 6d.
- 5. Our thanks are due to the clergy for their continued interest in the sick; to Mr. and Mrs. Raiker for their unremitting care and attention; and to our worthy Doctor for his able help in realising the present satisfactory condition of Hospital affairs.
