REPEAL OF REGULATIONS POSTPONEMENT BILL 2002

(Brought in by the Minister for Education, the Honourable Paula Catherine Wriedt)

A BILL FOR

An Act to postpone the repeal of certain regulations

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Repeal of Regulations Postponement Act 2002*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

Postponement of repeals

3. (1) The repeal of the regulations specified in Schedule 1 that, but for this section, was to have been effected on 1 January 2003 under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992* is postponed until 1 January 2004.

Administration of Act

- **4.** Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act* 1990
 - (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Education; and
 - (b) the department responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Infrastructure, Energy and Resources.
