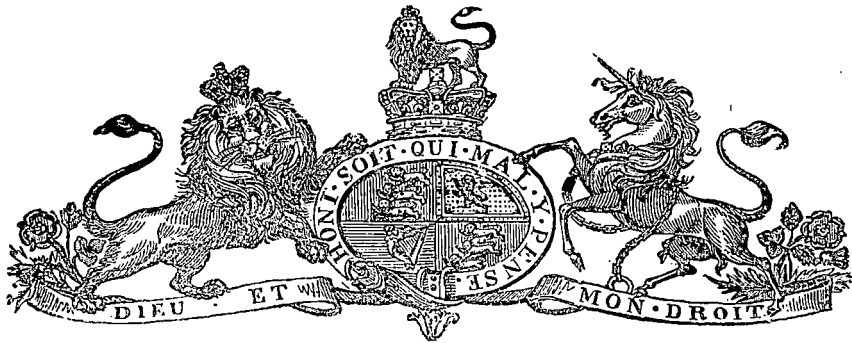

*To the Honorable the President and Members of the Legislative
