A BILL FOR

**An Act to amend the *Telecommunications
(Interception) Tasmania Act 1999***

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Telecommunications
(Interception) Tasmania Amendment Act 2004*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which this Act
receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, the *Telecommunications (Interception)
Tasmania Act 1999** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 3 amended (Interpretation)

4. Section 3(2) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (c).

Section 5 amended (Other records connected with an interception)

5. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (b) in subsection (1):
 - (ba) in relation to each warrant whose authority is exercised by the Tasmania Police Service, particulars of –
 - (i) the warrant; and
 - (ii) the day on which, and the time at which, each interception under the warrant began; and
 - (iii) the duration of each such interception; and
 - (iv) the name of the person who carried out each such interception; and
 - (v) in relation to a named person warrant, each service to or from which communications have been intercepted under the warrant;

- (b) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (1):

(1A) If a warrant is a named person warrant, the particulars referred to in subsection (1)(ba)(ii) must indicate the service in respect of which each interception occurred.
