THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House:—

KENTISH MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £800 for the purpose of lighting the District of Railton with electricity and for the reticulation of the scheme. After considering reports and estimates of the Hydro-Electric Department and hearing evidence from Mr. Curtis, Chief Engineer and General Manager of the Hydro-Electric Department, it was resolved to recommend the granting of the loan, with a sinking fund of two and a quarter per cent.
