Thank you for your Constituency Question on Tuesday 2 December 2025, in regard to the working with vulnerable people checks for volunteers.

Our volunteers hold such an invaluable role in our local communities, taking on many positions and working with so many important organisations.

To help our volunteers and in line with our 2025 State Election commitment, the Registration to work with vulnerable people check will be made free and provided to volunteers as part of a two-year pilot.

It is anticipated that the pilot will commence on 1 January 2026.

Importantly, the fee waiver will apply to both new registrations and those requiring a renewal.
