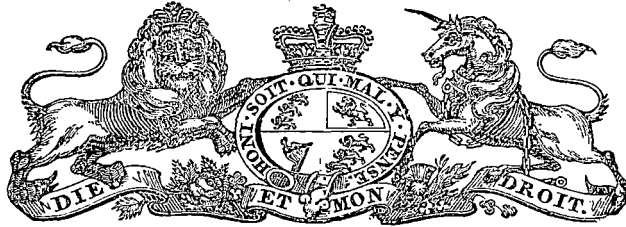

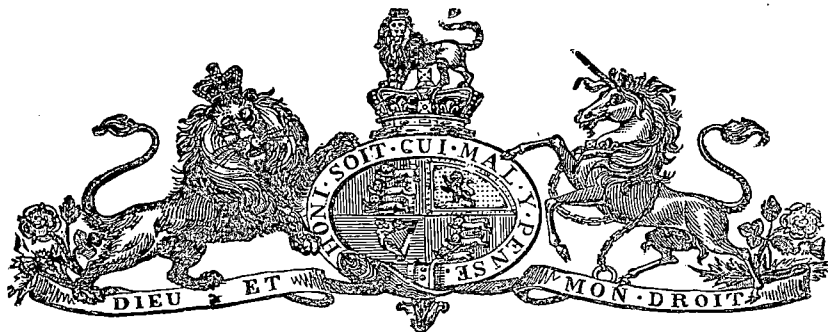

MINUTE No. 335.
