

# REPORT FOR 1884.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



#### NEW TOWN FARM.

#### 26th February, 1885.

I HAVE the honor to forward herewith the Annual Report, together with the Account Current, for the New Town Farm for the year 1884.

The gross receipts for the year amounted to £950 16s. 5d., while the expenditure for that period was £606 4s. 5d., leaving a balance in favour of the Farm of £344 12s. The net profit for the preceding year was £248 8s. 9d., while for the past year it was £344 12s.

The Farm consists of 100 acres, and the number of acres under cultivation remained the same as last year, and similar descriptions of crops were grown as heretofore.

The live stock on the 31st December was as follows :-- 4 horses, 1 bull, 27 cows, and 27 pigs.

During the year 18 calves and 72 pigs were bred on the Farm, and 74 pigs and 18 calves were disposed of for the amount of  $\pounds$ 149 0s. 9d.

The staff of the Farm remains the same, namely, two hired men with twelve invalids, all of whom have given entire satisfaction.

The various Institutions were fully supplied with milk throughout the year.
