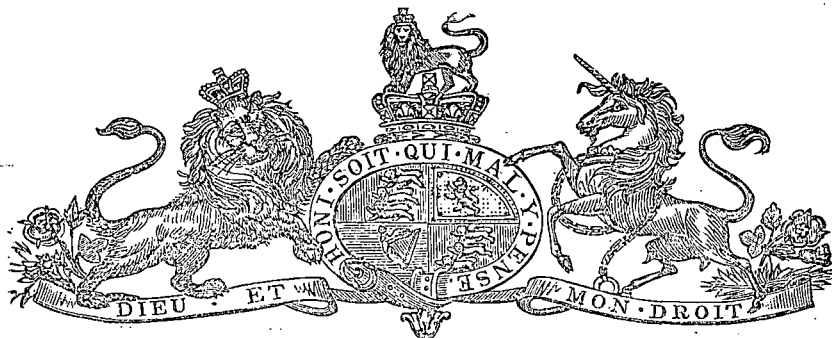

REPORT of The Hobart Fire Brigade Board for Year ending 31st December, 1894, made pursuant to Clause 13 of "The Fire Brigades Act, 1883."

DURING the year the Brigade attended 25 fires, as per schedule herewith, and the Superintendent reports the Firemen performed their duties in a satisfactory manner.

The net expenditure amounts to £796 1s. 1d., which is divided equally between the Government, Corporation, and Insurance Companies; Account attached hereto.

The Superintendent reports the plant and appliances of the Board in good order.
