



During the year the Brigade attended 25 fires, as per schedule herewith, and the Superintendent reports the Firemen performed their duties in a satisfactory manner.

The net expenditure amounts to £796 1s. 1d., which is divided equally between the Government, Corporation, and Insurance Companies; Account attached hereto.

The Superintendent reports the plant and appliances of the Board in good order.
