



PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL:

REPORT FOR 1893.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



REPORT of the Board of Management of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL for the Year 1893.

THE total number of patients treated was 67, as against 75 last year.

The amount received from paying patients was £31 1s. 3d., as against £61 6s. last year.

Subscriptions received, £58 15s. 9d., as against £106 10s. 10d. last year.

Grant in aid, £59 17s. 4d., as against £177 9s. 3d. last year.

An urgent appeal was made to the former subscribers, pointing out that the Grant in Aid would be payable on subscriptions secured only; the result is shown above, and exhibits a loss of £165 6s., which is far greater than was anticipated in last year's Report.

The Board has again to gratefully acknowledge donations of fruit, vegetables, clothing, books, flowers, and firewood from Mesdames Leake, Tofft, Stormont, Hart, Chaplain; Misses Turnbull, Valentine, Bell, Power; Dr. Tofft, and D. Taylor, Esq.

The Medical Officer has been assiduous in his attention, and the Clergy have paid frequent visits.

The Master and Matron have given every satisfaction, the Matron attentive to her indoor duties, and the Master devoting his spare time to the keeping of the grounds. The Board would strongly recommend them for the usual annual gratuity of £10.
