

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



## TASMANIA.

COMMISSION passed under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet, appointing Sir-Robert George Crookshank Hamilton, K.C.B., to be Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

## VICTORIA R.

Victoria, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Dated 14th Britain and Ireland Queen, Defender of the Faith, December, 1886.
Empress of India: To Our Trusty and Well-beloved Sir
Robert George Crookshank Hamilton, Knight Commander of Our Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Greeting.

WE do, by this Our Commission under Our Sign Manual and Signet, appoint Appointment of Sir the said Sir Robert George Crookshank Hamilton, to be, during Our pleasure, R. G. C. Hamilton, Chief in and over Our Colony of Tasmania and K.C.B., as you, the said Sir Robert George Crookshank Hamilton, to be, during Our pleasure, Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies, with all the powers, rights, privileges and advantages to the said office belonging or appertaining.

II. And We do hereby authorize, empower, and command you to exercise and His duties and perform all and singular the powers and directions contained in Our Letters Patent, bearing date at Westminster the Seventeenth day of June, 1880, constituting the Office of Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Our Colony of Tasmania and its 1880, &c. Dependencies, or in any other Letters Patent adding to, amending or substituted for the same, according to such Orders and Instructions as Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief for the time being hath already received from Us, or as you shall hereafter receive from Us.

III. And We do hereby appoint that, as soon as you shall have taken the Commission apprescribed oaths, and have entered upon the duties of your office, this Our present Commission shall supersede Our Commission under Our Sign Manual and Signet, bearing date the Twenty-ninth day of June, 1880, in the Forty-fourth year of Our Reign, appointing Our trusty and Well-beloved Major Sir George Cumine Strahan, Knight Commander of Our Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael seded. and Saint George, to be our Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Our Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

IV. And we do hereby command all and singular Our Officers, Ministers, and Officers, &c., to loving subjects in Our said Colony, and all others whom it may concern, to take obey the Governor. due notice hereof, and to give their ready obedience accordingly.

Given at Our Court at Windsor, this Fourteenth day of December, 1886, in the Fiftieth year of Our Reign.
